We're back with a Big Bang this term with an action packed January already underway. Tomorrow (Thursday) Spanish teachers will gather for the rearranged [INSET](#) day at Dulwich College. Next Wednesday (18th) will see lucky ticket holders attending the sold out Alleyn's [Chaplaincy Lecture](#).

The first student event of the year will be at Dulwich College when [Alex Bellos](#), the UK's highest profile speaker on mathematics, speaks to Year 10 and above students on Friday 20th January. That's when things get really busy... On Tuesday 24th January teachers will meet at JAGS to discuss approaches to delivering [EPQs](#) across the partnership. The SSLP's flagship student event, [God and The Big Bang](#), takes place on Wednesday 25th January. This interactive conference will provide a challenging debate for sixth students of all faiths and beliefs.

Also on Wednesday 25th is the second annual [Roots & Shoots](#) lecture at JAGS. In this charity event the BBC's Ben Garrod will talk about his work with the Great Apes and the Jane Goodall Institute. The month is rounded-off by a talk from historian [David Starkey](#) at Dulwich College on Thursday 26th.

February starts with the Sold Out [philosophy conference](#) at JAGS on Thursday 9th February. Also on Thursday 9th is [Professor David Gilbert](#) who will talk about studying geography at university and will engage students in Years 11 and above in a talk about Global Cities and the Geographical Imagination. This evening will begin with 'drinks' reception at 4.15 at Dulwich College.

Students from across the partnership are invited to attend two externally organised events on Friday 24th February. The second is for gifted and talented students in Years 10-13 and is a masterclass run by Oxford University entitled [Big Ideas for Bright Minds](#).
