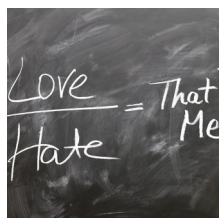

This Week



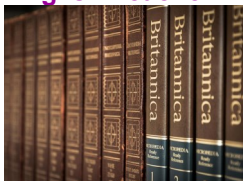

English Teacher Training



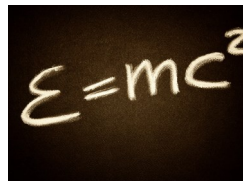
