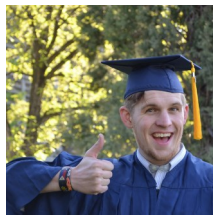

History - Nationalism & Security

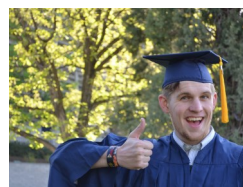
