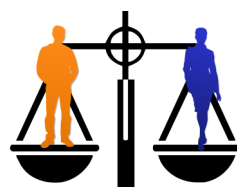
Geography - Professor David Green

PE - Faculty Review & Tennis



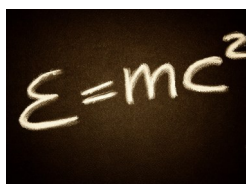
