### Leadership

- Meeting with and supporting the Directors as required
- Be an access point between Champions & the SSLP Directors and Co-ordinator
- Deputising for Directors on occasion
- Developing a medium to long term strategic plan for the partnership
- Engage with plans for an annual Champions conference
- Visit a designated selection of SSLP schools every year

  - o North Southwark (& Lambeth) Schools or

- Supporting new Staff Champions
- Promoting full attendance at SSLP meetings by communicating with SSLP Staff Champions
- Supporting the SSLP Coordinator with the newsletter and events
- Arrange social / team building events for Staff Champions
