

SSLP Schools

Membership of the SSLP is optional and is confirmed every year on receipt of the annual membership fee. Being an SSLP school means you are committed to working collaboratively with others in the partnership to provide joint learning opportunities for staff and students.

In order for every school to benefit from the partnership all partners should champion the SSLP aims by doing the following:

Communication

- Display the SSLP Logo on your school website
- Connect with the SSLP on social media
- Promote the SSLP to the school community including parents, councillors and MPs
- Include SSLP usage in school photograph permissions

Engagement

- Encourage staff and students to engage with events, sharing any news reports
- Provide contact details for all departmental leads
- Celebrate Student Ambassadors and other SSLP achievements

Leadership

- Recruit one or more Staff Champions to represent your school at the seven SSLP meetings
- Identify at least one Student Ambassador to be on the Student Council
- Meet with one of the Co-Directors at least once per year

Teamwork

- Offer support to other schools when requested
- Engage with subject Hubs and encourage leadership
- Host at least one partnership event per year and one meeting every alternate year
